CLASS "P"- MASTER CHAMPION CHALLENGE CLASS-

This is a newly adopted class by the NPGA where PGCH may enter to compete along with the Grand Champion of the show. Any animal with PGCH that wins the class is eligible to record a win toward a Master Champion title.

There will be no entry fee for this class, but you must include the animal on your entry form and check in with your PGCH papers prior to this class.

There will be one Class "P" for the does and one for the bucks held immediately after the selection of the grand champion for each of those shows. So bring those PGCH does and bucks back to the show ring!

Join us for a great goat extravaganza including Linear Appraisal Training!**

Check-In begins at 8:00 am. Check in must occur prior to entering the show ring for your class. You must have original NPGA papers with you at all times for does and bucks in order to show, and certificates for any wethers in order to record wins with NPGA. We will begin the day with a Showmanship at 9:00 am! Rebecca Mumpower will be judging the AM show. The PM show will begin at the conclusion of the AM show.

Entry fees are \$8.00 per animal if pre-entered (entry postmarked by 8/4/08; \$11.00 for late entries. Trophies and ribbons will be given at this show.

Where: Jamul, CA- 2 hours west of Yuma or south of Norco.

Bring only healthy animals. NPGA rules to govern and take precedence over all others.

Food and drinks will be available at the show grounds. There will be pens available or bring your own if you like! See entry form. Any arrangements to leave animals overnight must be made in advance of show at the discretion of the show committee. Pens must be reserved and are limited in number, so please reserve only what you need. Approx 4x4 in size.

E-mail ProuPygs@aol.com or call Donna Elkins at 619-669-0305 for overnight pens or lodging at the showgrounds. Comfort Inn in La Mesa (Parkway Dr) or Holiday Inn Express (Murray Dr.) in La Mesa are about 20 minutes from the show.

Directions-15662 Lyons Valley Road-Horse Ranch

From the north- Just take I-5 or I-15 to 94 east and follow it out through Spring Valley until it turns to a divided highway. Take a right at the third traffic signal to stay on Highway 94/Campo Rd. Go about 4.5 miles and turn left on Lyons Valley Rd. Go two miles to a 3-way stop....continue STRAIGHT through the stop sign (the street name changes to Skyline Truck Trail) and go 2 more miles. Turn right on Lawson Valley Rd. Go ¼ mile and make a sharp left back on to Lyons Valley Rd. The farm is 4 houses down on the left, just past the Elkins driveway.

From the east- (as in Arizona) take 8 west to Descanso/Japatul Valley Rd exit. Go left on to Japatul Rd and go about 6 miles. Turn left on to Lyons Valley Rd. Go about another 6 or 7 miles to 4-way intersection and turn right on to Skyline Truck Trail. Go about 5 miles and turn left on to Lawson Valley Rd. Go ¼ mile and make a sharp left back on to Lyons Valley Rd. The farm is 4 houses down on the left, just past the Elkins driveway.
